PAT FRANCIS's childhood was shaped by the Luftwaffe raids on London during WWII. In this delightful collection of poems she draws on her memories of nights in the air-raid shelter, and on the history of West Ham and Bethnal Green, — poverty, weavers, music hall, poets in Epping Forest. The poems are gathered into four groups: *Some Londoners*, *Blitz*, *Five Victorian Vignettes*, and *In the Forest*.

JANE COLLING accompanies the poems with eight line drawings evoking memories of London in the past.
